On query by Mr Somnath Das on representation to be made to GoS on the matter of minimum wage implementation, VC informed about the



loss of credibility amongst our employees with such representation considering the PPP model and aspirations of SMU employees. Giving representation to the Government prior to the Government notification is not considered prudent as it was publicly announced by HCM on 01 May 2022 on Labour Day. Gazette notification by GoS was issued only on 11 July 2022. VC also informed about the announcement by Hon'ble CM at SMU on 12 June 2022 where he told the University employees about the implementation. He further added that not implementing the proposal would have severe backlash, loss of credibility and discordant employer human resource relations which are fundamental to existential reality.

Mr Somnath Das advised Head, HR for statutory based HR requirement to be presented in the next UMC.

On query by CFO on insourcing of employees, VC informed that Director: SMIT the exercise is underway and would be completed & presented to UMC by the end of this month. Mr Nishith & Mr Somnath suggested for a comprehensive analysis on insourcing including fitment cost and also as per the compliance with the statutory requirements.
