CORRIGENDUM

In continuation to this Ministry's Notification No.U.12012/01/2017-ME.I dated 25.04.2017 and Corrigendum Nos. U.12012/01/2017-ME.I & Z.20015/07/2019-ME-I/FTS-3194591 dated 06.06.2017 and 25.06.2019 respectively, the Central Government, hereby makes the following further amendments in the First Schedule to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956:-

In the qualifications mentioned against "Sikkim Manipal Institute of Medical Sciences, Gangtok" under the heading 'Recognized Medical Qualification' [hereinafter referred to as column (2)], against the following qualifications and entry relating thereto under the heading 'Abbreviation for Registration' [hereinafter referred to as column (3)], the following shall be inserted, namely-

"Doctor of Medicine (General Medicine)"

MD (General Medicine)

(This shall be a recognized medical qualification when granted by Sikkim Manipal University of Health, Medical and Technological Sciences, Sikkim in respect of students being trained at Sikkim Manipal Institute of Medical Sciences, Gangtok on or after 2014.)

"Doctor of Medicine (Paediatrics)"

MD (Paediatrics)

(This shall be a recognized medical qualification when granted by Sikkim Manipal University of Health, Medical and Technological Sciences, Sikkim in respect of students being trained at Sikkim Manipal Institute of Medical Sciences, Gangtok on or after 2014.)

"Master of Surgery (Otorhinolaryngology)"

MS (ENT)

(This shall be a recognized medical qualification when granted by Sikkim Manipal University of Health, Medical and Technological Sciences, Sikkim in respect of students being trained at Sikkim Manipal Institute of Medical Sciences, Gangtok on or after 2014.)


"Doctor of Medicine (Psychiatry)"

MD (Psychiatry)

(This shall be a recognized medical qualification when granted by Sikkim Manipal University of Health, Medical and Technological Sciences, Sikkim in respect of students being trained at Sikkim Manipal Institute of Medical Sciences, Gangtok on or after 2015.)

- Note: a. The recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of Notification upon which the Institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition.
- b. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the Postgraduate Course.
